CWSS Under 8's Day 2022



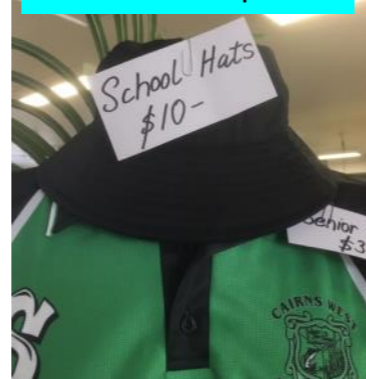
The Rewards Day will be held in Week 10 this term.

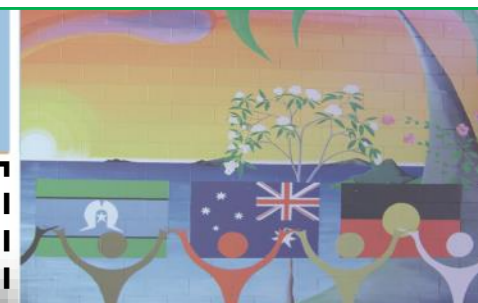
